During the Institute

Curriculum development

Develop at least one modular activity for your classroom (Create a module activity during the week), share it on guitarbuilding.org forum.

Team development is encouraged and Templates are provided

Cover implementation options and develop framework of an implementation plan

Experience 2 or more MLA applications during the institute

All 4 STEM topics covered throughout the week through MLA or discussion

Build a playable guitar

Peer review of grading guitars using guitar grading rubric

Complete Daily surveys and a post survey

Fill out necessary paperwork for incentive payment

To apply for a startup support STEM Guitar package that includes guitar kits, a tool kit, sandpaper set, and a drill block:

Provide a clear curriculum map/syllabus/operating structure and submit a Letter of commitment of implementation with plan

Implement 2+ core activities

Test your MLA developed at the Summer Institute (provide evidence of MLA student testing through end of MLA assessment that was developed)

Evidence of completing activities in classroom in the form of photographs of class is encouraged

Student surveys (Student Retrospective Survey will be emailed to the faculty directly or found on <http://www.guitarbuilding.org/surveys/>)

Plus, have a space in which to build guitars with students

Completion of the submission packet is January 31, 2019 awards will be made on February 15, 2019
